Mayor Staffieri Announces

Agreement Reached with Shelton on Shared Transfer Station Services for Derby Residents

Mayor Staffieri announced today that he has signed an agreement with Shelton Mayor Mark Lauretti which will allow Derby residents to conduct business at the Shelton Transfer Station located at 866 River Road in Shelton. There will be no additional fees for Derby residents as a result of this agreement. All curbside pick up of trash and recycling will continue as usual in Derby.

"I am extremely grateful to Mayor Mark Lauretti for his offer to help the residents of Derby. His insight and willingness to help immediately with the use of Shelton resources has resulted in no interruption of services for Derby residents. He recognized that Derby was trying to do the right thing and he wanted to extend his help as a neighboring community." Said Mayor Staffieri.

"Regional Cooperation is what the Valley is all about. I wanted to lend a hand to our good neighbors. It was the right thing to do. I have always recognized that working together benefits both of our communities." Said Mayor Lauretti

Derby's Transfer Station will officially close Friday, December 11, 2009 at 3pm in order to continue to work on resolving outstanding issues with the Connecticut Department of Environmental Protection (DEP). Residents of Derby can bring acceptable items to the Shelton Transfer Station as early as Monday, December 14, 2009.

"It is unfortunate that there were outstanding violations that have occurred over time. The City had an obligation to take immediate steps to address those violations, which included hiring a private company, Annex, that had already begun to make needed improvements in the short time they were at the transfer station. We are confident our transfer station will reopen in a timely fashion and that there will be no disruption for Derby residents." Said Alderman Ken Hughes.

The City of Shelton and City of Derby have entered into an Inter-Municipal Agreement for the acceptance of rubbish by the residence of the City of Derby. The following shall be collected by the City of Derby for its residents as follow:

Refrigerator	\$15.00

Non commercial trailers - Bulk/Constr.	\$20.00
Pickup trucks - Bulk/Constr.	\$25.00

THE CITY OF SHELTON WILL NOT ACCEPT BRUSH, TREES OR LEAVES.

All residents must first go to the Town Clerk's Office and pay for the items that they will dispose of at the City of Shelton Landfill.

The fees are indicated above. All transactions are cash only. The resident must provide identification verifying that they are a resident of Derby. A receipt will be issued that must be presented to the Shelton Landfill attendant.
